

RESOLUTION 19-01

A RESOLUTION FIXING AND PUBLISHING QUALIFYING FEES FOR OFFICES  
SUBJECT TO SPECIAL ELECTION IN 2019; REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS IN  
CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the Town of Tallulah Falls, Georgia (hereinafter the "Town") is the Mayor and Council thereof; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 21-2-131(a)(1) provides the governing authority of any county or municipality, not later than February 1 of any year in which a general primary, nonpartisan, or general election is to be held, shall fix and publish a qualifying fee for each office to be filled in the upcoming primary or election; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Tallulah Falls, in addition to complying with this 20 code section, intends to adequately notify the citizens of the Town in order to encourage public participation in the electoral process;

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the Town finds it desirable to safeguard and promote public health, safety, and general welfare for all citizens through the adoption of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Tallulah Falls and it hereby resolved by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION ONE. In the general election to be held on the November 5, 2019, the qualifying fee for Mayor shall be \$45.00 and Council Members shall be \$27.00, representing 3% of the current annual salary for each office.

SECTION TWO. The Town Clerk shall authorize the Rabun County Election Superintendent to publish all advertisements in the legal organ as required by state law.

SECTION THREE: Qualifying periods shall commence no earlier than 8:30 A.M. on the third Monday in August immediately preceding the general election and shall end no later than 4:30 P.M. on the following Friday.

SECTION FOUR: Qualifying will be held at the Rabun County Elections Office.

SECTION FIVE: All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed.
